A Proclamation for "Disabled American Veterans' Week"

WHEREAS, we recognize a special obligation and debt of gratitude to the many war veterans who have suffered disability in the defense of our nation; and

WHEREAS, it is highly appropriate that we express our appreciation to those veterans who have made this great sacrifice for the security of America; and

WHEREAS, "Disabled American Veterans' Week" is to be observed throughout the nation as a tribute to these heroes;

THAT, THEREFORE, I, LEWIS W. WAINWRIGHT, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week, beginning December 6 as

"DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS' WEEK"

and urge all citizens to participate in appropriate ceremonies in honor of our disabled war veterans of State and nation.
