A Proclamation for "Bill of Rights Day"

WHEREAS, the Bill of Rights is one of the great documents of American history; and

WHEREAS, through the years it has provided a guarantee of basic rights for all the people of our nation; and

WHEREAS, the American concept of freedom as contained in the Bill of Rights has enriched and inspired the whole world;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. JOHNSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December 16 as

"BILL OF RIGHTS DAY"

and urge our citizens to observe the occasion with appropriate ceremonies, in tribute and dedication to the spirit of this grand charter of liberty.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in Saint Paul this seventh day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight and of the State, the ninety-first.
