EXECUTIVE PROCLAMATION

A Proclamation in Memory of Governor Theodore Christensen

WHEREAS, Theodore Christensen gave to the State of Minnesota a devoted and distinguished career of public service; and

WHEREAS, he proved himself a most courageous and capable leader during the many years in which he contributed to the welfare of his beloved state and nation, as Governor, as Representative in the Congress of the United States, as a member of our State Legislature, as a member of the State Bar, and as a newspaper publisher; and

WHEREAS, the people of Minnesota have suffered a great loss in his death;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDALE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim that state offices shall be closed Tuesday afternoon, December 14, 1948, in heartfelt tribute to the memory of Theodore Christensen.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in Saint Paul this eleventh day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight and of the State, the ninety-first.
