Special Election

Marine Mills, Minn. October 7th 1912.

A Special Election was held this day in and for the Village of Marine, County of Washington, State of Minnesota, for the purpose to relinquish the old Village Charter of year 1875 with its amendments, and to Reincorporate under the general law of the State, according to Chapter #4 Sec. #699 of the revised law of 1905.

The votes was as follows:

For Reincorporation	67	votes
Against	7	"
Total	74	"

Therefore the Village Council hereby declare, as a result of said Special Election, that the Village of Marine is reincorporated under the general law of the State of Minnesota.

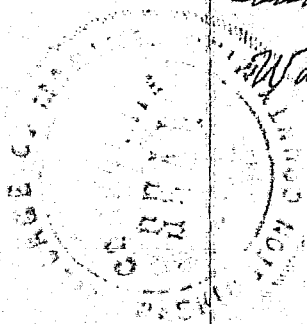
