WRIT OF ELECTION PROVIDING FOR FILLING THE VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF STATE SENATOR IN THE FORTY-SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT AT AN ELECTION TO BE HELD FEBRUARY 8, 1949, AND PROVIDING FOR THE NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES FOR SAID VACANCY AT A PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD JANUARY 31, 1949.

TO THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, AND PARTICULARLY OF THE FORTY-SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT OF SAID STATE; TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA; TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR OF THE COUNTY OF RAMSEY OF SAID STATE, AND TO ALL ELECTION OFFICERS IN THE FORTY-SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT, AND ALL OF THE SEVERAL ELECTION DISTRICTS THEREIN, AND TO ALL OTHERS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS a vacancy now exists in the office of state senator from the forty-second senatorial district in the State of Minnesota, caused by the death of the Honorable Charles N. Orr; and

WHEREAS there is occasion for the exercise of the functions of said office at the 1949 session of the Minnesota State Legislature so that a person elected to fill said vacancy could take office and exercise the functions thereof immediately after his election;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Luther W. Youngdahl, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting under the authority and direction of Section 17, of Article IV, of the Minnesota Constitution, and the statutes in such case made and provided, do hereby direct that said vacancy be filled at an election to be held in said district on Tuesday, February 8, 1949, and that candidates for said office be nominated at a primary election to be held in said district on Monday. January 31, 1949. That affidavits of candidacy for

nomination at said primary may be filed not later than the seventh day before said primary election; that notices of said elections and the conduct of said elections be had and all things pertaining thereto be done as provided in Sections 205.06 to 205.17, Minnesota Statutes 1945, and other applicable provisions of law.
