A Proclamation for "Jaycee Week"

WHEREAS, The United States Junior Chamber of Commerce and the Minnesota State Junior Chamber of Commerce are dedicating their efforts toward a greater America; and

WHEREAS, the young men of this nation set an example of civic consciousness through constructive action in their communities by participation in Junior Chamber of Commerce activities; and

WHEREAS, the program of service as presented by all Junior Chambers of Commerce is helpful in developing the leadership of the Nation's young men through the execution of projects designed to improve the welfare of the country; and

WHEREAS, The United States Junior Chamber of Commerce is observing its twenty-eighth year of service to the nation; and

WHEREAS, the highlight of this observance will be the selection and recognition of outstanding young men who have contributed meritorious service to their respective communities and the nation;

I, THOMAS E. WATSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, believing the aims, ideals and accomplishments of young men as exemplified by the Junior Chamber of Commerce are worthy of the attention of all citizens of this state, do hereby declare the interval between January 12th, and January 21st, 1949, as

"JAYCEE WEEK"

and urge all citizens of this state to give full consideration to the future service of the United States Junior Chamber of Commerce and its member organizations.
