A PROCLAMATION FOR UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA WEEK

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota was one of the first territories  
commercialized to establish a public University, provided  
for which was made in the Territorial Charter one hundred  
years ago; and

WHEREAS, the people of this state have displayed from the first an  
enthusiastic interest in the strength, efficiency and high  
standards of the University of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota, made up predominantly of people traditionally  
soaking progress, intellectual, technical and spiritual  
environment and high standards of citizenship, have shown  
unusually interest in and willingness to support higher  
education; and

WHEREAS, the week February 18 to 20 has been designated

GIVEN, THIS TWELFTH, I, SHERMAN M. WILLIAMS, Governor of the State of  
Minnesota, wishing in every way to encourage and re-inforce the long-  
existing and statewide admiration for the welfare and advancement of  
the University of Minnesota, do call on the people of all communities  
of the State to join during that week in special activities recognizing  
and honoring the University's services, and to dedicate themselves  
specially to its support.

State of Minnesota to be  
affixed at the State Capitol  
in Saint Paul this eighth  
day of January in the year of  
our Lord one thousand nine hundred  
and forty-nine and of the State,
