

ORDINANCE No. 37.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LOTS AND BLOCKS TO THE VILLAGE OF PINE RIVER.

The Village Council of the Village of Pine River, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Section 1.

That the following described lots and blocks or lands, Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter (NE 1-4 SE 1-4) and the North half of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter (N 1-2 SE 1-4 SE 1-4) all in Section 37, Township 138, Range 30, County of Cass, State of Minnesota, and abutting upon the incorporated Village of Pine River, be and the same are hereby annexed to such Village as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.
