A Proclamation for National Security Week

WHEREAS, the week of February 13 to February 20, 1943, Minnesota has been designated National Security Week in tribute to the work of thousands of members of the military reserve forces throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota has approximately 20,000 members who give willingly and untiringly of their time and efforts to the streamlining of the national defense program by participation as members of the Army Reserve, the National Guard, the Marine and Navy Reserve and Air Force, representing the greatest strength in this program in the history of the states; and

WHEREAS, National Security Week is sponsored by the Reserve Officers Association of the United States and the Minnesota Department of the Reserve Officers Association;

WHEREAS, it is highly appropriate that special recognition and honor be given the members of the military reserve who are making a vital contribution to the strength of our nation;

Now, therefore, I, Luther V. Youngdahl, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February 13 through February 20 as

"National Security Week"

and call upon all civic and patriotic organizations and all citizens to demonstrate by fitting and proper programs and ceremonies their whole-hearted support and appreciation of the work and efforts of our citizen soldiers in the military reserve forces.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in Saint Paul this eighth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine and of the state, the ninety-first.
