EXECUTIVE ORDER

A Proclamation for "National Security Week"

WHEREAS, the week of February 12 to February 18, 1943, inclusive, has been designated National Security Week in tribute to the work of thousands of members of the military reserve forces throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota has approximately 25,000 members who give willingly and unselfishly of their time and efforts to the strengthening of the national defense program by participation as members of the Army Reserve, the National Guard, the Marine and Navy Reserve and Air Force, representing the greatest strength in this program in the history of the state; and

WHEREAS, National Security Week is sponsored by the Reserve Officers Association of the United States and the Minnesota Department of the Reserve Officers Association; and

WHEREAS, it is highly appropriate that special recognition and honor be given the members of the military reserve who are making a vital contribution to the strength of our nation;

I, THOMAS E. LUTHER, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February 12 through February 18 as

"National Security Week"

and call upon all civic and patriotic organizations and all citizens to demonstrate by fitting and proper programs and ceremonies their wholehearted support and appreciation of the work and efforts of our citizen soldiers in the military reserve forces.
