

CERTIFICATE OF CONSENT

By the State of Minnesota to the Acquisition
of Certain Lands by the United States, Located
in Hennepin County, Minnesota for Military Purposes.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

WHEREAS, the United States of America on October 25, 1943 acquired fee simple title to 33.8 acres of land, more or less, as hereinafter described, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, subject to existing easements for public roads and highways, public utilities, railroads and pipe lines, which acquisition was accomplished by the filing of Declaration of Taking in a condemnation proceeding in the United States District Court in and for the District of Minnesota, Fourth Division, in an action of the United States of America Petitioner Vs. 33.8 acres of land, more or less, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, Albertine Miller et al, Respondents, as authorized by Act of Congress approved August 18, 1890 (26 Stat 316), as amended by the Acts of Congress approved July 2, 1917 (40 Stat 241), and April 11, 1918 (40 Stat 518; 50 U.S.C. 171), and March 27, 1942 (Public Law 507 77th Congress); and

WHEREAS, the United States acquired said land for use as a Modification Center in connection with a military airfield and for other military purposes,

NOW, THEREFORE, upon application of the Secretary of the Army of the United States, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1945, Sections 1.041 to 1.046, I, Luther W. Youngdahl, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby



certify for and on behalf of the State of Minnesota, that consent has been given to the United States of America to the acquisition of the lands hereinafter described and that exclusive jurisdiction has been ceded to the United States of America over the following described lands in the State of Minnesota, County of Hennepin, to-wit:

All of the fractional Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Thirty (30), Township Twenty-eight (28) North, Range Twenty-three (23) West, containing 33.8 acres, more or less;

subject to the right of the State of Minnesota to cause its civil and criminal process to be executed on the premises, which right is hereby reserved to the state.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto, this 7th day of January, 1949, set my hand as Governor of the State of Minnesota, and affixed hereto the Great Seal of the State.
