EXECUTIVE ORDER

A Proclamation for "Brotherhood Week"

WHEREAS, the National Conference of Christians and Jews annually sponsors the observance of one special week as "Brotherhood Week"; and

WHEREAS, it is the worthy purpose of this observance to help promote justice, unity, understanding and cooperation among all of the Protestant, Catholic and Jewish faiths; and

WHEREAS, our nation can be strong only as we put into practice the principles and ideals of American brotherhood; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that our citizens of Minnesota join in the activities of this special week;

THE, THEREFORE, I, THOMAS W. YALOWITZ, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week, beginning February 29, as

"BROTHERHOOD WEEK"

so that we may all join in a recommitment to the eternal principles of brotherhood, in common with the citizens of other states, and strive to live by these American principles during all the weeks of the year.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in Saint Paul this nineteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine and of the state, the ninety-first.
