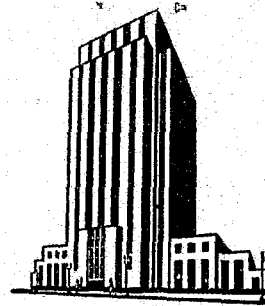

Appliance Company, located at 1534 West Larpenteur Avenue on the "Proposed Incorporation of the Village of "Falcon Heights", hereby certify as follows:

- (1) That a map was prominently displayed during the election showing the boundaries of the affected territory, which were the Rosslawn Avenue, West Fulham Ave., St. Paul City Limits, and Hamline Avenue.



Moniek, duly elected and qualified County Auditor in and for Ramsey County, Minnesota, do hereby certify the attached petition asking that the territory therein described be incorporated into the Village of "Falcon Heights", and that an election be held for that purpose, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of said Ramsey County at its meeting held in the Court House in the City of St. Paul in said County of Ramsey on the 14th day of February, 1949, and that on the 7th day of March, 1949, the said Board of County Commissioners duly adopted a resolution directing the undersigned to give notice that an election would be held on the 29th day of March, 1949, and appointing Lynn Matteson, George J. Shavor and Arthur Lindig, residents of said territory, as inspectors to act as Judges of said election.

WHEREAS, A petition was on February 14th, 1949 filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Ramsey County, Minnesota, praying that the following described territory, situated in the Township of Rose, County of Ramsey, State of Minnesota, and bounded as follows:

"On the north by the center line of Roselawn Avenue West; on the west by the center line of Fulham Avenue; on the south by the south boundary of the Township of Rose, which is the north boundary of the City of St. Paul, and on the east by the center line of Hamline Avenue."

be incorporated under the name of Village of "Falcon Heights", under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1945, Chapter 412.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That an election be held at the L & L Appliance Co., located at 1534 West Larpentour Avenue on Tuesday, March 29, 1949, within the territory described in said petition, where the voters, duly qualified and actually residing within the said described territory may vote for or against said incorporation, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the polls for said election be opened between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 8:00 P. M., and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That Lynn Matteson, George J. Shavor and Arthur Lindig, residents of said territory, be and they are hereby appointed inspectors to act as Judges of said election and are directed to conduct same in accordance with the statutes in such case made and provided and insofar as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That Eugene A. Monick, County Auditor, be and he is hereby directed to cause copies of said petition, together with a notice of said election to be posted in three public places within said territory.

To The Board of County Commissioners, Ramsey County, State of Minnesota:

The undersigned hereby propose the incorporation as a village of the following territory, situated in the Township of Rose, County of Ramsey, State of Minnesota, and bounded as follows:

On the north by the center line of Roselawn Avenue West; on the west by the center line of Fulham Avenue; on the south by the south boundary of the Township of Rose, which is the north boundary of the City of St. Paul, and on the east by the center line of Hamline Avenue, a plat of which is attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof, the territory proposed to be incorporated being that shown within the red lines on said plat.

The undersigned represent as follows:

They are voters who have resided continuously in the area above described for at least two years immediately prior to the date of this petition. The area contains approximately one thousand four hundred forty (1,440) acres. Included within the area are nineteen (19) plats duly and legally certified and filed in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for Ramsey County, Minnesota. The platted property contains approximately three hundred and forty-three (343) acres, and consists of the following plats: Larpenteur Villas; Keller Manor; Midway Plains; Husby; Falcon Heights Addition; Keller's Rearrangement of Block 10 of Falcon Heights; Keller's Falcon Heights; the Crossroads; Snelling Manor; Annie L. Hendrickson's Acre Lots; Labalestra Park; Clark's Five Acre Lots; Auditor's Subdivision No. 71; Cross Roads Court; Cable's Hamline Heights Addition; Northome; Northome Second Addition; Northome Third Addition; and Barthel Villas. The unplatted area is adjacent to the said plats.

The said platted areas are largely used for residential purposes. A large portion of the unplatted area is divided into small miscellaneous descriptions and has been so conveyed and is being largely used for residential purposes. The southerly line of said area is adjacent to the limits of the City of Saint Paul. The said platted area is largely developed as a suburban area to the said cities. The remainder is rapidly being platted, divided, and used for residential purposes. The entire area is used and developed so as to be properly subjected to village government.

A census of the resident population of the said area was accurately taken commencing February 8th, 1949, and ending February 9th, 1949, and the number of actual residents is 3,843. The proposed name of the said village is Falcon Heights.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof are the oaths of three of the said petitioners verifying the accuracy of the census and the truth of the statements made herein.

WHEREFORE, YOUR PETITIONERS REQUEST The Board of County Commissioners of Ramsey County to call an election for the determination of the proposed incorporation of the said village as provided by law.
