

AMENDMENT TO SECTION 21, CHAPTER IV OF THE CITY CHARTER.

"Section 21. The council, after each General Municipal Election, shall appoint a Clerk, an Auditor, an Assessor, an Attorney, and a Purchasing Agent. The Council may remove any of said appointees at any time.

After each General Municipal Election held on or after the first Tuesday in April, 1949, each member of the Council shall have the power, by and with the advice, consent and vote of approval and confirmation of not less than three-fifths (3/5) of the council, to appoint the administrative heads of all the sub-divisions in his division except those mentioned in this section. He may thereafter remove at will all such administrative heads of all sub-divisions in his division, and subsequent appointments to fill any vacancy thereby created shall be made in the same manner as hereinabove provided. He may also appoint and remove all deputies, clerks, assistants, laborers and servants necessary to transact the business of the city in his division, subject to the Civil Service provisions of this charter; except that the Attorney shall have the power to appoint and remove his own assistants; and provided further, that by <sup>a</sup>four-fifths (4/5) vote of the Council it may remove any appointee of any member of the Council or any assistant of the Attorney.

This amendment shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its ratification and adoption."
