The above entitled matter came regularly before the Court at the courtroom in the Norman County Courthouse, in the City of Ada, Horman County, Minnesota, pursuant to notice duly given, on April 25, 1949, at the hour of two elelek in the afternoon of said day, the Hon. Faul A. Lundgren, Judge, presiding. That at said time and place a petition to smend the original petition to include Section 24 and Section 13 of Halstad Township, described as Township 145 Range 46, Norman County, Minnesota, signed by six resident freeholders and owners was presented to the Court.

After due consideration of the evidence adduced at said hearing and of all the files and records in said proceeding and it appearing to the Court that these proceedings were instituted under and by virtue of Chapter III Minnesota Statutes of 1941, as amended, the Court makes and files the following Findings of Pact and Order:

FINDINGS OF PAGE

- I That all persons appearing at said hearing the expressed a desire to be heard either for or against the granting of the rolles prayed for in the petition in said proceedings testified at said hearing.
- 2 That a petition in due form, signed by more than sixty residents and freeholders of the territory mentioned therein and setting forth the facts required by said Chapter III was duly filed in the office of the Clerk of said Court on February 7, 1949, and that said petition substantially describes and designates the lands of the proposed district within the watershed of the Wild Rice and March Rivers within Norman County, Minnesota.
 - 3 That at the time of filing said potition the bond required

by said Court, was filed with said Clerk of Court.

- h That thereafter said Clerk notified a Judge of said Court of the filing of said petition and bond as provided by said Chapter 111.
- 5 That on the 15th day of Merch, 1949, the Hon. Faul A. Eunigren, one of the Judges of the Fourteenth Judicial District of the State of Minneseta, signed an Order and caused the same to be filed with said Clerk of Court, wherein the said Judge fixed the time and place of hearing on said potition as provided in said Chapter 111.
- 5 That due and propor notice of said time and place of said hearing has been made by the publication of a Notice of said hearing for three successive weeks in a legal weekly newspaper within the County of Norman, to-wit: the Norman County Index; and that the last publication of said Notice occurred at least ten days prior to the date fixed in said Notice for hearing on said petition; that due proof of said publication has been filed in the office of said Clerk of Court.
- 7 That the lands described in the potition to amond the original potition, adding to the proposed district Sections 24 and 13 of Halstad Township, described as Township 145 Range 43, Norman County, Minnesota, were by order of the Court included in and made a part of the original proceedings herein, said petition to amend having been received and filed without objection.
- Findings is situate within the drainage basin of the wild Rice and Marsh Rivers in the County of Norman and State of Minnesota; that said territory consists principally of agricultural lands; that a large area of the lands in said territory are in need of drainage; that in times of high water the wild Rice and Marsh Rivers overflow their banks causing a large territory to be everflowed and immedated, resulting in great damage to lands and growing crops and also having a tendency to injure the public health; that under the conditions

now existing in said territory the waters in said district are not properly conserved.

- 9 That it is for the best interest of the lands hereinafter described in Paragraph 13 of these Findings, and the purposes of eaid Chapter 111 will be best subserved by the inclusion of the lands described in the patition to amend the original potition herein.
- 10 That all of the lands and territory situate within the boundary line hereinafter in this paragraph designated is included within the drainage basin of the Wild Rice and March Rivers in Horman County, Minnesota, and said boundary line is hereby designated as follows, to-wit:

Commonding at the Northwest corner of Section 19, Township
1h5 Range 17, thence south along the section line 2 miles
to the Southwest corner of Section 30, 1h5-17, thence East
1 mile to the Southwest corner of said Section 30, thence

South 10 miles to the Southwest Corner of Sec. 20, 113-17,
thence East 5 miles to the Southeast corner of Sec. 21,
113-17, thence North 3 miles to the Northeast corner of
Sec. 14, 113-16, thence East 3 miles to the Southeast corner
of said Sec. 1, thence East 2 miles to the Southeast corner
of Sec. 25, 1141-16, thence North 1 mile to the Northeast corner
of Sec. 29, 1141-16, thence East 2 miles to the Southeast corner
of Sec. 29, 1141-15, thence East 1 mile to the Northeast corner
of Sec. 21, 1141-15, thence East 1 mile to the Southeast corner
of Sec. 21, 1141-15, thence Worth 3 miles to the Southeast corner
of Sec. 21, 1141-15, thence Worth 1 mile to the Northeast corner
of Sec. 31, 1141-15, thence Worth 1 mile to the Northwest corner

boundary lines, together with Sections 13 and 24 of Halatad Township, described as Township 1/15, Rango 43, Norman County, Minnesota, which by amendment of petition is hereby added to the proposed territory, is contiguous territory situate in the County of Norman, State of Minnesota.

ll That a survey has heretofore been made of said territory by the United States Corps of Army Engineers in its survey of the Rod River of The North drainage basin; that in and by said report filed on August 13, 194, the following channel improvements were recommended:

13 That the establishment of a drainage and conservancy district as provided by Chapter 111 Minnesota Statutes, 1941, as amended, will be conducive to public health, safety and convenience and promote the volfare of the inhabitants of the district and be

It That the average annual loss to the district by floods is in excess of \$100,000.00; that there is need for the work as proposed by the Corps of United States Army Angineers; that said proposed work will be conducive to public health, safety and convenience and promote the wolfare of the inhabitants of said territory.

IT IS THEREFORD ORDERAD, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the lands and territory herein described in Paragraph 10 of these Findings be and the same hereby is organized as a body corporate under and pursuant to the provisions of said Chapter 111 Minnesota Statutes, 1941, as amended, and that the name of said body corporate shall be:

"The Wild Rice - Marsh River Drainage and Conservancy District." and that the same shall include all the lands and territory embraced within the boundary line thereof, tegether with Sections 13 and 24, Township 145, Range 43, of Horman County, Minnesota; and the boundary line thereof is hereby designated as set forth in said Paragraph 10 of these Findings;

That the office and principal place of business of said Wild Rice - Marsh River Drainage and Conservancy District shall be at the City of Ada, Norman County, Minnesota;

That the Board of Directors of said district shall be and consist of five (5) Commissioners and that the following named persons, resident freeholders of said territory, shall be and hereby are appointed as the first Board of Directors thereof, to-wit:

R. G. Canning of Hendrum, Minnesota and L. R. Batrum of Ada, Minnesota, who shall hold their office for a period of two (2) years; and Mike Reesch of Ada, Minnesota, Stennes Austinson of Hendrum, Minnesota, and W. C. Ripley of Ada, Minnesota, who shall hold their office for a period of four (i) years;

That said Commissioners shall first qualify and then organize as provided by Scotion 111.08 Minnesota Statutes, 1944, as Amended;

Let The Glerk of said Court forthwith notify each of said Commissioners of his appointment.
