EXECUTIVE ORDER

A Proclamation for "Minnesota Correct Posture Week"

WHEREAS, the National Chiropractic Association and its affiliates, the Minnesota Chiropractic Association, have designated the week beginning May 1 as National Correct Posture Week; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this week is to develop national appreciation of the value of correct posture in promoting health; and

WHEREAS, teachers, recreational and athletic directors, Boy and Girl Scouts, 4-H clubs and similar groups will be encouraged to participate in this program to impress upon youth and all the public the importance of correct posture;

I, THOMAS J. LEVY, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 1 to May 7, 1949, as

MINNESOTA CORRECT POSTURE WEEK

and urge all citizens, especially boys and girls, to observe the week by striving to develop habits of good posture.
