A Proclamation for "Child Health Day"

WHEREAS, the President of the United States, in accordance with a resolution by the Congress, has designated May 1 as Child Health Day; and

WHEREAS, this day is set aside to provide all groups interested in bettering conditions for our children an opportunity to unite and rededicate themselves in helping build "Better children for our Nation, a better Nation for our children;" and

WHEREAS, the future of our state and nation depends directly upon our efforts to advance the total health of our children--their physical, mental and emotional well-being;

BEY, THOMPSON, I, LUTHER W. WYNGGARD, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 1 as

CHILD HEALTH DAY

and urge all agencies, organizations and citizens interested in the welfare of children to observe this special day by considering how to best develop in their community programs that will help our children obtain the benefits of good health through the continual improvement and extension of health services for children in the communities of our state.
