A Proclamation for "Conservation of Vision Week"

WHEREAS, unimpaired vision is one of the most precious elements of good health and vital to the fullest enjoyment and usefulness of life; and

WHEREAS, the conservation of eye sight requires the continued practice of safety rules by all citizens and constant vigilance to detect early symptoms of eye defects, particularly among our children; and

WHEREAS, careful research shows that seventy-five per cent of all blindness can be prevented by practicing proper rules for the care of the eyes, by using industrial safe-guards, by insuring proper lighting in the home, school and work shop and by obtaining proper professional care; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Society for the Prevention of Blindness, in conjunction with the Minnesota Safety Council and the Minnesota Department of Education, has worked out a sound program of preventive measures and education which is of benefit to everyone;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. WYLAND, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 22 to 28, 1949


CONSERVATION OF VISION WEEK


