Which resolution being seconded by Commissioner Heikkenen was duly adopted, all members voting "AYE".



TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CROW WING COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

The undersigned voters, who have resided for a period of at least two (2) years prior to the date of this petition within the territory described in Exhibit A, hereto attached and made a part hereof, which territory is not now in any incorporated village in the State of Minnesota, and part of which has been platted into lots or blocks, or is land adjacent to said platted portion, the plat of which has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State of Minnesota and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County of Crow Wing, being the county in which said lands lie, and said territory containing a resident population of not more than 3000 or less than 100, and all of which unplatted property is such as properly to be subject to village government, hereby petition your honorable board to call an election for the determination of a proposed incorporation of all the said territory described in Exhibit A as a village under the name of the Village of Fifty Lakes.

Your petitioners further show that a census of the resident population residing upon and within said territory described in Exhibit A has been duly taken and that the names of the people and persons permanently residing within and upon said territory are set forth in Exhibit B, hereto attached and made a part hereof; that said census was taken on the 11th day of March, 1949; and that the boundaries of such territory and the quantity of land proposed to be incorporated are fully set out in Exhibit A.

EXHIBIT A

BOUNDARIES OF THE PROPOSED INCORPORATED VILLAGE

Bounded by the present boundary lines of the Township of Allen, namely, from Section One (1) to Section Six (6), Township One Hundred Thirty Eight (138), Range Twenty Seven (27), bounded on the north by Cass County; thence from Section Six (6) to Section Thirty One (31), Township One Hundred Thirty Eight (138), Range Twenty Seven (27), and bounded on the west by Cass County; thence from Section Thirty One through Section Thirty Six (36), Township One Hundred Thirty Eight (138), Range Twenty Seven (27), and bounded on the south by the Village of Manhattan and Watertown Township; thence from Section Thirty Six (36) through Section One (1), Township One Hundred Thirty Eight (138), Range Twenty Seven (27), and bounded on the east by Emily Township; excepting from said territory all that part incorporated as part of the Village of Manhattan Beach and described as follows:

Government Lot Four (4) and the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty One (31), Government Lots One (1), Two (2) and Three (3), and the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$ $NW\frac{1}{4}$), of Section Thirty Two (32), the West Half of the Southwest Quarter ($W\frac{1}{2}$ $SW\frac{1}{4}$), and the West Half of the Northwest Quarter ($W\frac{1}{2}$ $NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty Nine (29), except the south 75 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$ $NW\frac{1}{4}$) excepting the easterly 100 feet thereof, and the north 75 feet of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ $NW\frac{1}{4}$) excepting the easterly 100 feet thereof, and all of Section Thirty (30) excepting therefrom a strip of land 150 feet wide, 75 feet north and 75 feet south of the center line of the now existing State Aid Road No. 1 which travels in an easterly and westerly direction along the north quarter line of said Section, all being in Township 138 North, Range 27 West, Crow Wing County, Minnesota.
