A Proclamation for "Union Label Week"

- WHEREAS, the American Federation of Labor will sponsor a nation-wide observance of Union Label Week as a means of better acquainting consumers with high-quality Union Label products; and
 - WHEREAS, the observance will feature many civic and social events and will emphasize the value of the Union Label in serving as a link for good relations among labor, management and consumers; and
 - WHEREAS, the Minnesota State Federation of Labor is participating in the many valuable activities of this special week; and
 - WHEREAS, the Union Label is an emblem which signifies the product is the work of expert craftsmen who subscribe to existing standards of skill and have joined together in an organization for the mutual benefit of all workers and the economic well-being of the nation;
- BEFORE ME, FREDERICK J. WATSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 9-23 as

"UNION LABEL WEEK"

and urge all citizens to consider the importance of the high quality workmanship and good citizenship which the Union Label signifies in our State.
