A Proclamation for "Cooperative Month"

WHEREAS, the cooperatives have played an important role in the first one hundred years of Minnesota history; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Association of Cooperatives is making plans for a special commemoration of the Minnesota Centennial; and

WHEREAS, the month of October has been designated as the time in which to present these Centennial programs and to call attention to the contributions of cooperatives to the growth of Minnesota during this first century;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER V. YOUNGQUIST, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1949, as

"COOPERATIVE MONTH"

In honor of our cooperatives and the pioneer leaders and pioneer members of the cooperatives of our state.
