WHEREAS, we commemorate during 1949 the one-hundredth anniversary of the establishment of Minnesota as a political entity; and

WHEREAS, among our pioneers were people of Yugoslav descent who proved themselves to be good citizens and made many contributions to the growth and progress of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that we should pay honor to our citizens of Yugoslav descent during this Centennial Year;

I, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGBLAD, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 10th and 11th as

"YUGOSLAV CENTENNIAL DAYS"

and call upon all citizens to join in this observance of special tribute to our pioneers of Yugoslav descent.
