




KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, do hereby constitute and appoint Edward J. Devitt of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Attorney to act for the State of Minnesota in proceedings to be instituted on request of the Commissioner of Business Research and Development in the District Court, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Compensation to be paid by said Commission of Business Research and Development shall on the request of the Commission be \$50.00 per day when appearing in court actions and \$35.00 per day when office work only is required.




