A Proclamation for "National Home Week in Minnesota"

WHEREAS, National Home Week will be celebrated throughout the United States this year during the period of September 11 through September 17; and

WHEREAS, now, probably more than at any other period of our history, there is a dire need for housing and homes for our people; and

WHEREAS, there is a strong American tradition in favor of home ownership, which is good for the state, its communities, the nation; and

WHEREAS, the home is one of the foremost, cherished institutions in the American way of life and essential to our stability and progress as a nation and as a people;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. WYNN, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby officially proclaim the week beginning September 11, 1949, as

"NATIONAL HOME WEEK IN MINNESOTA"
