A Proclamation for "Parent-Teacher Enrollment Month in Minnesota"

WHEREAS, the Parent-Teacher Associations provide an opportunity to bring into closer relation the home and the school through cooperation; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Congress of Parents and Teachers has more than 125,000 members working together for our children; and

WHEREAS, the month of October has been designated as a time for enrolling new members for the 1949-50 Parent-Teacher year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HENRY W. THOMAS, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1949, as

PARENT-TEACHER ENROLLMENT MONTH IN MINNESOTA

and urge all citizens to consider the many contributions made by our Parent-Teacher Associations and to join in these valuable activities for the benefit of our children.
