EXECUTIVE ORDER

A Proclamation for "Grandmother's Day in Minnesota"

WHEREAS, the National Grandmother's Club is an outstanding organization dedicated to the glorification of Grandmotherhood, to the encouragement of research on children's diseases, and to the promotion of better radio programs, better nutrition, better schools and better recreational facilities for the grandchildren of America; and

WHEREAS, the Club is now organized in most of the states of the Union; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota was proud to be the host of the 1948 National Conventions of the group; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota has an active organization in the Club and will be represented at the 1949 Convention in Atlanta, Georgia;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDALE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, October 9, as

GRANDMOTHER'S DAY IN MINNESOTA

in honor of the many contributions made to our state by all grandmothers and, especially, by those who are members of the National Grandmother's Club and working for its worthy goals.
