A Proclamation for "Steuben Day"

WHEREAS, the 17th day of September is the birthdate of General Friedrich Von Steuben; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that we should honor the memory of General Von Steuben, who contributed greatly to the founding of our nation by his loyal and able service as Inspector General of the American Army under George Washington in the Revolutionary War; and

WHEREAS, this is also the thirtieth anniversary of the establishment of the Steuben Society of America, which claims many citizens of Minnesota as members;

BEFORE ME, LUTHER W. YOUNGDALE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 17, 1949, as

STEUBEN DAY

in tribute to the memory of General Friedrich Von Steuben and his gift of military leadership to our nation in its early days of trial.

BY MY HAND AND SEAL, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed this sixteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine and of the state, the ninety-second.
