A Proclamation for "Apple Week"

WHEREAS, the week of October 20th to November 5th has been designated as National Apple Week and will be celebrated throughout the United States in connection with Halloween; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota has harvested a bountiful crop of large and excellent apples this year; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Committee on National Apple Week is carrying on a program of education and entertainment for our children in connection with Halloween; and

WHEREAS, the program will include the selection of a Prince and Princess of Apples from Minnesota children; and

WHEREAS, observance of this week can help our farmers who grow apples, bring better nutritional standards to our diet, and encourage wholesome recreation for our children;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDALE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 20 to November 5th as

"APPLE WEEK"

and urge all citizens to join in this week and to enjoy the benefits and delights of this wonderful fruit.
