A PROCLAMATION FOR "FUTURE MEMBERS OF AMERICA - GOLD"

WHEREAS, The Future Members of America is a national organization of girls and young boys which includes the 4-H Club, 4-H Council, 4-H Foundation, and 4-H Camps;

WHEREAS, Minnesota now has thirty-three units of the organization and 2,200 active members; and

WHEREAS, The organization supplements 4-H Club work with an opportunity for girls to develop initiative in group projects which contributes to the solution of problems important to home, school and community.

WHEREAS, The objectives of the Future Members are planned to promote a greater appreciation of the joys and satisfactions of humanity, to emphasize the importance of morally pure conduct, to encourage democracy in home and family life, to promote individual participation, to foster the development of creative leadership in home and community life, to provide wholesome recreation and to further interest in civic activities; and

WHEREAS, The State, when in the State Constitution in our day of 1858, so greatly recognized by the contributions of this outstanding youth program;

Now, therefore, I, ARTHUR E. VANDERKAM, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week beginning October 30 as

FUTURE MEMBERS OF AMERICA WEEK

and urge all citizens to take notice of the many contributions of the Future Members of America to our state, and to encourage in every possible way the future growth of this organization.
