A Proclamation for "Future Homemakers of America - Girl"

- WHEREAS, the Future Homemakers of America is a national organization of junior and senior high school students who are studying homemaking; and
- WHEREAS, Minnesota now has sixty-three active chapters of the organization and 2,450 active members; and
- WHEREAS, the organization supplements homemaking class work with an opportunity for girls to develop initiative in group projects which contribute to the solution of problems important to home life; and
- WHEREAS, the activities of the Future Homemakers are planned to promote a greater appreciation of the joys and satisfactions of homemaking, to emphasize the importance of cordy home membership, to encourage democracy in home and family life, to promote international good will, to foster the development of creative leadership in home and community life, to provide wholesome recreation and to further interest in home economics; and
- WHEREAS, the home, which is the basic institution in our way of life, is greatly strengthened by the contributions of this outstanding youth program;

Now, therefore, I, THOMAS W. YERGEN, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week beginning October 30 as

"Future Homemakers of America Week"

and urge all citizens to take notice of the many contributions of the Future Homemakers of America to our state, and to encourage in every possible way the future growth of this organization.
