Ned Easton being first duly sworn, on oath says: That he is, and during all the times herein stated has been a part owner and one of the publishers of the newspaper known as Stillwater Weekly Gazette, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated; that for more than one year prior

to the publication therein of the Pub. Ordinance # 15  
of the Village of Lake Elmo, Minnesota,

hereinafter described, said newspaper was printed and published in the City of Stillwater, in the County of Washington, State of Minnesota, on Thursday of each week; that during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the said City of Stillwater from which it purports to be issued as above stated in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single column, two inches wide; has been issued every Thursday of each week from a known office established in said place of publication and employing skilled workmen and equipped with the necessary material for preparing and printing the same and the presswork on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of interest to the community which it purports to serve, was done in its known office of publication; that during all said time in its makeup not less than twenty-five per cent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve; that during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements; has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local post office; and that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Washington County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper.

**ORDINANCE NO. 15**  
**ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS**  
**IN DESCRIBED TO THE VILLAGE OF LAKE ELMO, MINNESOTA.**  
The Village Council of Lake Elmo ordains:  
Section 1. That the following described tracts of land situated in Washington County, Minnesota, to-wit:  
1. That part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Twenty-nine (29) North, Range Twenty-one (21) West, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point in the section line between Sections Thirteen and Fourteen, said Township and Range, where the center line of Trunk Highway No. 212 of the State of Minnesota (formerly known as the Stillwater and St. Paul Road) intersects the same, said point being 2269.3 feet south from the corner of sections Eleven, Twelve, Thirteen and Fourteen, said Township and Range; running thence north on said section line, 510.4 feet; running thence east at right angles, 226 feet; running thence south parallel with the section line aforesaid, 281.6 feet more or less to the center line of said Trunk Highway No. 212; running thence south 55 degrees, 16 minutes west along said center line, 399.8 feet to the point of beginning.  
2. All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Twenty-nine (29) North, Range Twenty-one (21) West, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point in the center line of Trunk Highway No. 212 of the State of Minnesota (formerly known as the Stillwater and St. Paul Road) which point is 399.8 feet northeast of a point in the west line of said Section Thirteen, measured along said Highway, said point being the southeast corner of property owned by School District No. 17, Washington County, Minnesota; running thence north parallel to said west section line, 500 feet to a point; running thence east at right angles, 712 feet more or less to the center line of said Trunk Highway No. 212; running thence southwesterly along the center line of said Trunk Highway No. 212 to the point of beginning.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption, signature, attestation and publication as provided by law.
