

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

Be it known that on the 12th day of December, 1952, a petition for the inclusion of additional territory within the Meeker County Soil Conservation District, signed by more than twenty-five land occupiers, was duly filed in the office of the State Soil Conservation Committee;

That on the 3rd day of March, 1953, in the Community Hall at Litchfield, Minnesota, a public hearing was held after due notice of the said hearing had been given as required by law;

That on the 17th day of March, 1953, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that there is need in the interest of public health, safety and welfare, for including the additional territory within the Meeker County Soil Conservation District and did define the boundaries of such additional territory;

That thereafter due notice was given of a referendum to be held within the territory so defined by the Committee on the question of inclusion of said territory within the said district;

That the said referendum was held within the said defined boundaries on the 10th day of April, 1953;

That the result of the said referendum showed that a majority of the votes cast in the said referendum were in favor of the inclusion of said additional territory within the said district;

That thereafter on the 20th day of April, 1953, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that inclusion of the said additional territory within the said district is administratively practicable and feasible;

That the boundaries of the said additional territory were defined by the State Soil Conservation Committee as follows:

The townships of Danielson, Acton, Cosmos, Cedar Mills, Forest City, Forest Prairie, Greenleaf, Harvey, Litchfield, Manannah, Swede Grove, and Union Grove, in the County of Meeker, Minnesota.

There shall be exempted from the area bounded by the above described boundaries all lands used exclusively for religious, school or burial purposes; all parts and parcels of lands in cities, towns and villages which lands are used principally for residential purposes or for business purposes other than farming; all lands in rural or urban areas of three acres or less; and all lands of five acres or less which are used exclusively for woodlot purposes.


Whereas, Edward Billing, of Deuel, Minnesota, and Ernest Penati, of Deuel, Minnesota, the duly appointed supervisors of the Necker County Soil Conservation District, acting pursuant to the Minnesota Soil Conservation Districts Law, Laws of Minnesota for 1937, Chapter 461, approved April 26, 1937, and Laws of Minnesota 1943, Chapter 274, approved April 2, 1943, have filed in this office an application subscribed and sworn to by each of them before an officer authorized by law to take and certify oaths, setting forth: (1) that a petition for the creation of the district was filed with the State Soil Conservation Committee, pursuant to the provisions of the State Soil Conservation Districts Law, and the proceedings specified in said Act were taken pursuant to such petition, that said application was filed in order to complete the organization of the district as a governmental subdivision and public body, corporate and politic and that the State Committee has appointed them as supervisors; (2) the name and official residence of the district supervisors, together with a certified copy of the appointments evidencing their right to office; (3) their term of office; (4) the map which is proposed for the district; and (5) the location and principal office of the supervisors of the District; and

Be it known that on the 2nd day of April, 1951, a petition for the inclusion of additional territory within the Meeker County Soil Conservation District, signed by more than twenty-five land occupiers, was duly filed in the office of the State Soil Conservation Committee;

That on the 2nd day of April, 1951, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that there is need in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, for including the additional territory within the Meeker County Soil Conservation District and did define the boundaries of such additional territory;

That thereafter due notice was given of a referendum to be held within the territory so defined by the Committee on the question of inclusion of said territory within the said district;

That the said referendum was held within the said defined boundaries on the 27th day of April, 1951;

That the result of the said referendum showed that a majority of the votes cast in the said referendum were in favor of the inclusion of said additional territory within the said district;
