CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION OF OPTIONAL PLAN OF VILLAGE GOVERNMENT

(Note: this form and four other forms for use in elections on optional plan adoption appear in an article entitled "How to Adopt Optional Plans of Village Government", MINNESOTA MUNICIPALITIES, September, 1949, pp. 293-299.)

To the Secretary of State and ~~County Auditor~~ of the County of Kanabec:

I, Elsie C. Peterson clerk of the village of Mora, do hereby certify that at a ~~special~~ (the general) election held in the village on Dec. 6, 1949, the following question was submitted to the voters of the village:

"Shall Optional Plan A, modifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor, be adopted for the government of the village?"

I further certify that the affirmative votes cast on the foregoing proposition were 187 and the negative votes were 131 and the question of adoption of Optional Plan A received an affirmative majority of the votes cast on the question.

This certificate should be signed in duplicate by the clerk. One copy should be filed promptly with the county auditor and another with the Secretary of State if the optional plan is adopted. No certificate need be filed if the proposal is defeated.

Appropriate changes should be made if Optional Plan B or Optional Plan C was submitted instead. If Optional Plan B is submitted the law provides that the question should be stated as follows:

"Shall Optional Plan B, providing for the council-manager form of village government, be adopted for the government of the village?"

If Optional Plan C is submitted the question should be stated:

"Shall Optional Plan C, providing for the commission form of government,
be adopted for the government of the village?"
