I, F.A. Dunn, clerk of the village of Hills, do hereby certify that at a regular election held in the village of Hills on ~~###~~ December Sixth 1949 the following question was submitted to the voters of the village;

" Shall Optional Plan A, modifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor, be adopted for the government of the village?

I further certify that the affirmative votes cast on the foregoing proposition were 141 and the negative votes were 87 and the question of adoption of Optional Plan A received an affirmative majority of the votes cast on the question.



Shall Optional Plan a, modifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor, be adopted for the government of the village?


