A Proclamation for "Good Neighbor Day"

WHEREAS, this year marks the 18th annual observance of Good Neighbor Day, sponsored by the Good Neighbor Foundation; and

WHEREAS, this annual observance calls attention to the desire of all patriotic, home-loving Americans to be friends with the people of all nations; and

WHEREAS, the spirit of this day should be kept alive throughout the year as we strive to set an example of neighborliness and good will with other nations; and

WHEREAS, we must also strive for greater neighborliness and friendship in our own communities;

I, THOMAS E. LUTHER, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, January 1, 1950, as

"GOOD NEIGHBOR DAY"

and call upon all citizens to do their part in spreading friendliness and neighborliness in commemoration of this annual observance.
