WHEREAS, during his lifetime, George Washington Carver set an example of selfless service to God and his fellow men; and

WHEREAS, the National Achievement Club will sponsor on January 6, the anniversary of this great scientist's death in 1943, a special program in his honor; and

WHEREAS, this day has been set aside as "Carver Day" by act of Congress and Presidential proclamation;

BUT, THEREFORE, I, LUCILLE L. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 6, 1950 as
