

ORDINANCE NO. 31

An Ordinance Declaring Certain Land Annexed
to the Village of Goodview, Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Goodview
having determined, upon the petition of the Winona Sand
and Gravel Company, owner of all the land described
below, that inclusion within the Village and annex-
ation thereto of said land will be to the best interests
of the Village and of the territory affected;

The Village Council of the Village of Goodview
ordains:

Section 1. The following described land be
and the same hereby is annexed to the Village of Goodview
in the County of Winona, State of Minnesota:

Southwest Quarter of the Southeast
Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section
Eighteen (18), Township One Hundred
Seven (107) North, of Range Seven (7)
West of the Fifth Principal Meridian,
in the County of Winona, State of
Minnesota, except that part thereof
southwesterly of the center line of
the right of way of the Chicago,
Great Western Railroad Company
(.0003 acres, more or less).
