A Proclamation for "National Youth Week"

WHEREAS, the United Christian Youth Councils of Minneapolis and Saint Paul are planning an observance of National Youth Week, in cooperation with the United Christian Youth Movement of North America; and

WHEREAS, adults have a sacred obligation to help young people develop to the fullest of their capabilities in preparation for good citizenship and responsibilities of leadership and service; and

WHEREAS, the need for educational opportunity, wholesome recreation, proper medical care, spiritual development and good family life for all youth merits our constant attention and concern;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER V. VOLLMER, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 30 to February 6, 1950, as

NATIONAL YOUTH WEEK

and urge all citizens to join in this observance by considering plans for the improvement of our services to the youth of the state.
