The Village Council of Wolf Lake ordains:

That the following described properties be annexed to the village of Wolf Lake and become a part thereof:

North two hundred fifty feet (250') of government lots two (2) and three (3), Section four (4). Township one hundred thirty eight (138) north, Range thirty seven (370) west of the

5th principal meridan, consisting of approximately 15 acres and: Commencing at the Northwest (N.N.) corner of Section three(3) Township one hundred tharty eight (138), Range thirty seven (37). west of the 5th principal meridan. Thence, three hundred sixty three feet (363') south to the point of beginning. Thence, three hundred thirty three feet (333') east. Thence, one hundred feet (100') south. Thence, three hundred thirty three feet (333') west. Thence, one hundred feet (100') north to the point of

beginning, consisting of 1.1 acres.
