Dear Sir:

Please Take Notice, that the undersigned, Lloyd K. Johnson, intends to apply to the Commissioner of General Land Office at Washington, D. C., for the survey of three groups of islands as public lands of the United States.

These islands are described as follows:

Group A - This group is about 10 to 15 feet above the water, about one acre in area, is about 700 feet from Lot 1 in Section 32, Township 56 North, Range 7 West, and would be, if the quarter lines were extended into the lake, in the Northeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 32, and the Northwest corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 33.

Group B - These islands are about 40 to 50 feet above water, consist of about two acres in area, and are about 300 feet from Lot 2 in Section 32, Township 56 North, Range 7 West, and were the quarter lines extended throughout Section 32, they would lie in the Northeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 32, and in the Northwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 32.

Group C - These islands are from 20 to 25 feet above water, about one-half acre in area, and about 700 feet from the shoreline of Lot 2 in Section 32, Township 56 North, Range 7 West, and were the quarter lines extended throughout said section, they would lie in the Southeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 32.

This notice is given pursuant to statutes that a notice of intention to apply for the survey of an island or land as public land of the United States must be served upon the Attorney General and the Secretary of the State in which the land is situated, an
