


OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, do hereby, on request of the Commissioner of Business Research and Development, constitute and appoint Irving Gotlieb of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Attorney to act for the State of Minnesota in proceedings to be instituted on request of said Commissioner and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Compensation to be paid by the Department of Business Research and Development is, on the request of said Commissioner, hereby fixed at \$50.00 per day when appearing in court actions and \$35.00 per day when office work only is required.


