

ORDINANCE NO. 210

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, MINNESOTA.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON DO ORDAIN:

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 413.14 of the Minnesota Statutes for 1911, all the owners of property hereinafter described and abutting upon the City of Worthington, have petitioned the City Council of said City of Worthington to have such property annexed to said City:

AND WHEREAS, It is desired that said territory become a part of said City of Worthington, the same as if it had been originally a part thereof;

AND WHEREAS, The following described territory is hereby declared to be a part of the City of Worthington; to-wit,

That part of the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 14, Township 102, Range 40, in the County of Nobles and State of Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 14, thence easterly along the south line of said Section 14 a distance of 165 feet, thence at right angles in a northerly direction a distance of 340 feet, thence at right angles in a westerly direction a distance of 170 feet, thence at right angles in a southerly direction a distance of 64 feet, thence at right angles in a westerly direction a distance of 101 feet, thence at right angles in a southerly direction a distance of 34 feet, thence at right angles in a westerly direction a distance of 275.4 feet, thence at right angles in a northerly direction a distance of 122.6 feet, thence at right angles in a westerly direction a distance of 500.55 feet, thence southeasterly parallel with the westerly line of the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railway right of way a distance of 384.93 feet to the south line of said Section 14, thence in an easterly direction on said south line of said Section 14, a distance of 75.10 feet to the place of beginning.

and

A tract of land in the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 14, Township 102, Range 40, described as follows:

Commencing at a point 1277.4 feet East of the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 14 as the place of beginning; thence east on the section line a distance of 213 feet to the right of way of the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railway; thence North at an angle of 70 degrees 19 minutes West along the said railway right of way, a distance of 485 feet; thence West and parallel to the South line of said Section 14 a distance of 213 feet; thence southeasterly and parallel to said railway right of way line a distance of 485 feet to the place of beginning.
