

ORDINANCE NO. 230

AN ORDINANCE TO ADD TO THE TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON,
MINNESOTA.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON TO ORDAIN:

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 813.1b of the Minnesota Statutes for
1951, all the owners of property hereinafter described and abutting upon
the City of Worthington, have petitioned the City Council of said City of
Worthington to have such property annexed to said City;

AND WHEREAS, It is desired that said territory become a part of said
City of Worthington, the same as it had been originally a part thereof;

WHEN, THEREFORE, The following described territory is hereby declared
to be a part of the City of Worthington to-wit,

That part of the South Half (S½) of Section 1b, Township 102, Range
40, in the County of Nobles and State of Minnesota, described as follows:
Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 1b,
thence easterly along the south line of said Section 1b a distance of 165
feet, thence at right angles in a northerly direction a distance of 340 feet,
thence at right angles in a westerly direction a distance of 170 feet,
thence at right angles in a southerly direction a distance of 31 feet,
thence at right angles in a westerly direction a distance of 275.4 feet,
thence at right angles in a northerly direction a distance of 122.6 feet,
thence at right angles in a westerly direction a distance of 500.55 feet,
thence southwesterly parallel with the westerly line of the Chicago, Rock
Island and Pacific Railway right of way a distance of 386.03 feet to the
south line of said Section 1b, thence in an easterly direction on said
south line of said Section 1b, a distance of 795.10 feet to the place of
beginning.

and

A tract of land in the South Half (S½) of the Southwest Quarter (SW¼)
of Section 1b, Township 102, Range 40, described as follows:

Commencing at a point 1479.4 feet West of the Southwest corner of the
Southwest Quarter (SW¼) of said Section 1b as the place of beginning; thence
out on the section line a distance of 213 feet to the right of way of the
Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railway; thence North at an angle of
70 degrees 19 minutes West along the said railway right of way, a distance
of 889 feet; thence West and parallel to the South line of said Section
1b, a distance of 213 feet; thence southwesterly and parallel to said
railway right of way a distance of 665 feet to the place of beginning.
