A Proclamation For "World Day of Prayer in Minnesota"

WHEREAS, Friday, February 24, 1950, has been designated as World Day of Prayer by the United Council of Church Women; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Council of Church Women joins in the sponsorship of this day, which provides an opportunity for people of all religious denominations, races and nationalities to unite in seeking Divine help for the crucial problems of our time; and

WHEREAS, prayer was never more needed than it is today in dissolving the stress and strain of human selfishness, bigotry and greed;

I, THOMAS W. WOODRUFF, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, February 24, as

"WORLD DAY OF PRAYER IN MINNESOTA"

and earnestly call upon all citizens to participate in the observance of this day by offering prayers to Almighty God and seeking Divine guidance to sustain us in meeting the challenges of life.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventh day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty and of the state, the ninety-second.
