TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
COUNTY OF MEEKER,
STATE OF MINNESOTA.

GENTLEMEN:

Pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Laws of Minnesota for 1949, we the undersigned, being resident within the territory containing a population of not less than one hundred (100) persons, hereby petition your Board for incorporation of the Village of Cedar Mills, County of Meeker, State of Minnesota.

A census list has been made by three voters residing within the area proposed to be incorporated as a village, and said census list is attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A", and made a part hereof.

That the boundaries of the territory to be embraced within the Village of Cedar Mills, County of Meeker, State of Minnesota, are as follows:

That portion of Sections Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14) of Township One Hundred Seventeen (117) North, Range Thirty-One (31) West, platted as "Cedar Mills" by City Investment Company on December 4, 1922, and filed for record in the ~~XXXXX~~ office of the Register of Deeds of Meeker County, State of Minnesota, on December 7, 1922 at 10 A. M.; and that portion platted as "First Addition to Cedar Mills" by Frank & Emma Schlueter on March 30, 1949, and filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Meeker County, State of Minnesota, on April 6, 1949; Also the East Half of the Northeast Quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Fourteen (14), and the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Thirteen (13).

The boundaries of the proposed Village of Cedar Mills are indicated upon a drawing marked "Exhibit B", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The undersigned state that each of them have resided continuously within the territory proposed to be incorporated as the Village of Cedar Mills for at least two years prior to the date hereof.

WHEREFORE, The undersigned respectfully request that your Board call an election on the question of incorporation, pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Laws of Minnesota for 1949.

INCORPORATION OF VILLAGE OF CEDAR MILLS, MEEKER COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

A motion was made by Commissioner Werner that the Board of County
Commissioners adopt the following Resolution;
