A Proclamation for "National Wildlife Restoration Week"

WHEREAS, the thirteenth annual observance of National Wildlife Restoration week will be observed this year; and

WHEREAS, this special week of reflection upon the riches of our natural resources and the importance of perpetuating them was instituted by the National Wildlife Federation in 1938 and was then officially announced by Presidential Proclamations; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota, which has been blessed with an abundance of natural resources, has an obligation to preserve the fertile soil, the forests, the lakes and streams, the scenic beauty, the wildlife and other beautiful gifts of nature;

I, THOMAS W. WELCH, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim March 19 to 26 as

"NATIONAL WILDLIFE RESTORATION WEEK"

and urge all citizens to rededicate themselves to the protection and restoration of our natural resources during this week.
