

**NOTICE OF FINAL HEARING ON
PETITIONS AND ENGINEER'S
AND VIEWER'S REPORTS**

Notice Is Hereby Given, that a
petition was filed in the office of
the Clerk of the District Court of
Norman County, Minnesota, by the
Board of Directors of the Wild
Rice-Marsh River Drainage and
Conservancy District asking that a
time and place be fixed for a hear-
ing upon the petition by the Coun-
ty of Norman to said board, the
report of the engineer for said
board, and the report of the view-
ers on benefits and damages and
list of lands assessable; and that
at the hearing an order be made
establishing the improvement and
authorizing the construction there-
of, and confirming the reports of
the engineer and the viewers and
fixing the rights of the parties;
and the Court, the Honorable Paul
A. Lundgren, Judge presiding, hav-
ing by order fixed Tuesday, April
25th, at 10 o'clock A. M. at the
Court room of the Norman County
Court House at Ada, Minnesota as
the time and place for hearing
thereon.

Now Therefore, you are hereby
notified that the starting points,
the general description of the lands
through which the improvements
will be located, and the terminals
thereof are as follows:

Marsh River

Beginning in Government Lot 2
of Section 18, Township 144 N.,
Range 45 W. at a point where a
sluice dam and sluice channel leave
the Wild Rice River, thence in a
northerly direction to the north
line of said Section 18, thence west-
erly along or adjacent to the south
line of Section 12, Township 144 N.,
Range 45 W., to the southwest
corner of said Section 12, thence
following the present improved
channel of the Marsh River through
