A Proclamation for "World Government Week"

WHEREAS, mankind is confronted with the grim problem of preventing the outbreak of another world war, which, with the use of modern weapons, could well mean the end of our civilization; and

WHEREAS, the United World Federalists organization has designated a special week for consideration of plans for further strengthening the United Nations into a world federal government with authority to enact, interpret and enforce world law adequate to assure peace; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota chapters of the United World Federalists are actively participating in this nation-wide effort to provide the people with information on the importance of a world federal government in the maintenance of justice and peace;



"WORLD GOVERNMENT WEEK"


and urge all citizens to join in this observance by public discussion and consideration of the proposals for effective world government, as the greatest hope for the elimination of war.
