ORDINANCE NO. 111

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE BOUNDARY LINES OF SAID VILLAGE OF LE CENTER, MINNESOTA, SO AS TO INCLUDE IN SAID VILLAGE THE LANDS BELOW AND IN THE ORDINANCE DESCRIBED, AND MAKING SAID LANDS A PART OF SAID VILLAGE.

The Village Council of Le Center, Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

Section 1 — That the following land, to-wit:

Lots Three (3) and Four (4) in Block One (1), and Lot One (1) in Block Two (2), in Hobday's

Addition to the Village of Le Center, according to the recorded plat of said addition on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Le Sueur County, Minnesota.

lies adjacent to and joins said Village on the north.

Section 2 — That the boundary lines of said Village of Le Center, Minnesota, are hereby extended and enlarged to include said above lands together with any adjoining streets and alleys within the Village limits of the Village of Le Center.
