



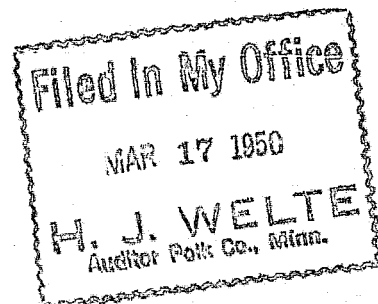

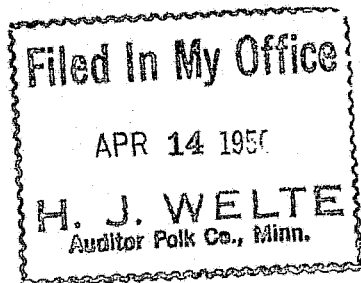

Whereas, on the 16th day of March, 1950 a petition was filed with the County Board of Polk County, Minnesota and signed by more than 25 voters who had resided in the following described territory to-wit: all of section 30, Township 150 North, Range 39 West, containing 640 acres more or less according to the government survey, Polk County, Minn., continuously for a period of at least two years prior to the date of the petition, and

Whereas, one hundred and twenty-three persons were actually residing in the foregoing described territory as of the census taken on the 11th day of March, 1950, and

Whereas, the petitioners requested that the County Board of Polk County, Minnesota, call an election for the determination to incorporate the foregoing described territory and to be known as the Village of Trail, Minnesota, and

Whereas, the petition was duly verified by the three census takers, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Board of Polk County, Minn., hereby approves the petition as to form and contents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the election for or against the incorporation of the foregoing described territory be held at the hall of the Veterans of Foreign Wars in Trail, Minn. on the 18th day of April, 1950 and that the polls be opened at 10:00 o'clock A. M. and closed at 7:00 o'clock P. M.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that P. N. Mohn, E. H. Harper and P. G. Peterson, residents of the territory, be and hereby are appointed to act as judges of the election.

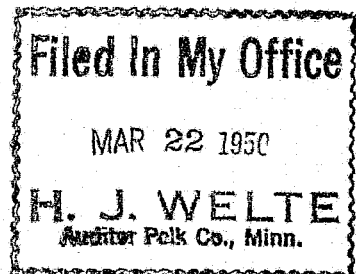
